

HOUSE OF ITALY SCHOLARSHIP

The House of Italy, HOI, plans each year to award scholarships to "full time" post high school vocational, community college or university students of Italian descent who are either a member of, or directly related to an HOI member. A major or minor in Italian language or Italian Studies is not a prerequisite; however, consideration will be given to the applicant's course of study.

Two House of Italy scholarships will be awarded annually each in the amount of \$1,000. Funding of the House of Italy scholarships will be paid to the scholarship winners in two \$500 installments

ELLIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. Must be accepted/enrolled in an accredited post high school, vocational, community college or university.
- 2. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 (A=4.0, B=3.0, etc.) as revealed by official transcript, in high school or post high school education.
- 3. Must be a member or directly related to an HOI member, whether Italian or not, with a minimum of 1 year of continuous membership.
- 4. Age not greater than 25 years.

SELECTION PROCESS:

A committee composed of officers and members of the House of Italy will review all completed applications that meet eligibility requirements. If none of the applicants meet the requirements, the HOI will not award scholarships.

Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of:

- 1. GPA
- 2. .350 word essay or letter in response to: Please provide an explanation of your course of study and tell what is the basis of your interest in the Italian culture and how do you plan to promote awareness of the importance and contributions of Italian culture in your community?
- 3. One letter of recommendation from a teacher, faculty or community leader

TIMELINE:

- 1. Completed applications submitted no later than MAY 15, 2018.
- 2. Selections by JUNE 1, 2018
- 3. Announcement of Scholarship Recipients at the JUNE 17, 2018 General Membership Dinner meeting.
